If you're aged 15 or over and want to complete training or work ask your Unit Coordinator to refer you to JETTS.

You can be sentenced or on remand.

JETTS is available regardless of where you will be living after release.

JETTS is a voluntary program.

What is JETTS?

JETTS is a jobs and skills program that helps you prepare for work for when you get back in the community.

With the support of JETTS you can prepare yourself for work through:

- Identifying what training you might need
- Understanding what a workplace will expect of you
- Knowing what you need to organise so you are ready to work on release.

You can take part in JETTS while you're in custody and the program counts as part of your exit planning.



What can JETTS do?

- Help you to identify employment or training interests
- Work with you to develop an employment training transition plan
- Help you complete your resume
- Help you develop skills to prepare you for work – like personal presentation, interview techniques, problem solving
- Link you with training/employment or with services that will support you with this on your release
- Arrange a Job Capacity Assessment if you have a medical condition or disability.

Ongoing support

JETTS will keep in contact with you and your support team to see how you're going in training or employment.

JETTS can also link you with other options in the community.

JETTS can remain involved for up to 12 months after your release and can link you with other community supports if needed.
